

## Frequently Asked Questions

Minnesota Monitoring, Inc. wants to help both the student and the parent to understand the procedures involved with chemical abuse testing. Often, there are questions that you are skeptical to ask, however, we encourage them to help educate all that are involved.

Q. How long will it take to get results?

A. All instant screening devices will produce a result within 5 to 10 minutes. If it is sent to the laboratory for testing, results will be rendered within 1 to 3 business days upon receipt at the laboratory.

Q. Do we need to make an appointment?

A. For DNA, Hair Follicle Testing, or the Patch you need to call ahead. All other services DO NOT require you to call ahead; walk-in basis, first come first serve

Q. Are the Results kept Confidential?

A. When clients arrive for testing they are asked to execute a Release of Information. Only persons listed on the Release will be provided with any information. If you would like the test to be purely confidential, and for your own information, it will be treated as such.

Q. What are your hours of operation?

A. Minnesota Monitoring is open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Including holidays.

### Directions from Highway 169

Highway 169 to Medicine Lake Road

**East** -Medicine Lake Road to Nevada Ave.
